

# Autumn Greeting Cards

## Materials

- clear mac-tack (pre-cut to fit a sheet of paper folded in half)
- paper (coloured construction paper or any other heavy paper)
- an assortment of fall leaves (make sure they're clean and dry!)
- markers, pencil crayons, crayons



## Instructions

1. Fold a piece of paper in half to be the base of your card.
2. Draw a simple design on a separate sheet of paper.
3. Peel the backing off of the mac tack and lay it sticky side up on the drawing.
4. Stick whole leaves or a mosaic of leaf pieces following your drawn design (note: when the mac tack is applied to your card, the design will be reversed).
5. Reverse and stick on the paper.

(Younger girls can skip the drawing and just create a pattern of leaves).
